### **The Community of the Missionaries of Jesus**

*The Missionaries of Jesus (MJ) is an international and multicultural religious missionary community. It was founded in the Philippines on 12 June 2002 by a group of forty-one priests (mostly missionary peers of Fr. Aloy) called and inspired by the mission and humanity of Jesus, who calls us to “make disciples of all nations” (Mt 28:19).*

*MJ work for and are in solidarity with the marginalized sectors of society - the indigenous communities, the urban poor, migrant workers, refugees, and displaced populations.*

*At present, they are working in the Philippines in the Diocese of Antipolo, the Diocese of Baguio, the Archdiocese of Davao, the Prelature of Marawi, the Apostolic Vicariate of San Jose in Occidental Mindoro, and in various places in Metro-Manila. Some MJ are also engaged in the Diocese of Lae in Papua New Guinea, in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in the USA and in the Apostolic Vicariate of Peten in Guatemala.*
