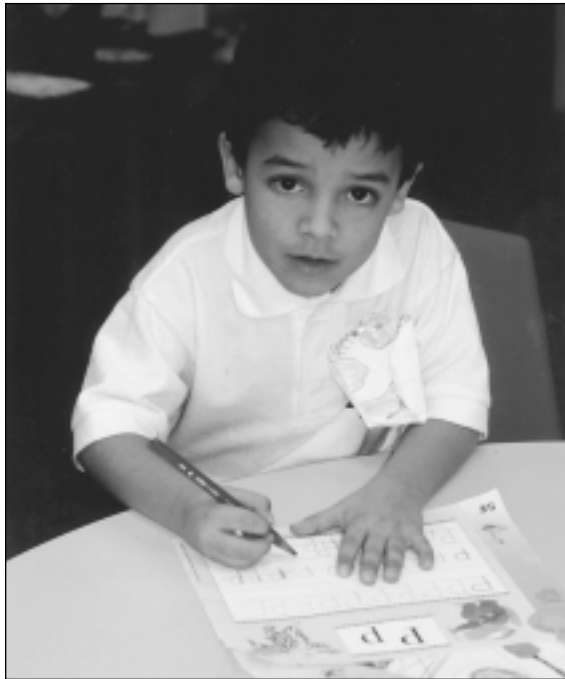


a challenge for excellence . . .
